

## Green Hills Church Life Group Commitment Form

**PURPOSE:** To create an environment where participants are encouraged to live out the great commission, great commandment and to multiply the group.

### VALUES & GOALS:

**Relationships** - While prayer and discussion of curriculum are key elements of a community group, the driving force behind the group is the building of relationships.

**Authenticity** - The atmosphere of a Small Group should encourage openness and transparency among members. This is an environment where people should feel free to be themselves.

**Confidentiality** - For authenticity to occur, members must be able to trust that issues discussed with a Small Group are not to be shared outside of the group.

**Respect** - Group members should never say anything that will embarrass their spouse or members of the group.

**Availability** - A primary responsibility of community is to prioritize for specific relationships. This requires a willingness to be available to meet each other's needs.

**Multiplication** - Group members recognize that one of the goals of their group is to start a new group within 18-24 months. This allows others to experience the Small Group relationship.
